Your donation provides a full turkey dinner for homeless and low-income families in Philadelphia (Project H.O.M.E.) and Norristown (Sisters of Charity)!

Please include the following in your Thanksgiving Baskets:

- 15 pound frozen Turkey (wrapped or sealed in plastic)
 - 4 cans of various seasonal vegetables
 - 2 boxes of stuffing mix
 - 5 pound bag of potatoes
 - 2 cans of cranberry sauce
 - 2 jars of applesauce
 - 2 jars of gravy
 - dinner rolls
 - 1 non-frozen pie
1. Buy the turkeys from **WEIS** (Germantown Pike store *only*), **Giant** (Township Line store *only*) or **McCaffrey's** (Routes 73 & 202 store *only*) at the customer service desk. The stores hold all the turkeys for us.
 2. Purchase the rest of the items listed above and pay for them at check-out.
 3. Drop off the turkey receipt at the rectory and **drop off the rest of the food goods at the Parish Center (front door facing Walton Road)** before or after any of the masses on the weekend before Thanksgiving (November 17-18).

If you wish to donate a turkey purchased at another store, please call me to arrange where and when to drop it off since we have very limited freezer space.
