From Father:

Greetings from Prague!

As I write this column, I send you warm greetings from Prague, the beautiful capital of the Czech Republic. This city is rich in history and culture, but it is also home to a beloved and profound devotion — the Infant Jesus of Prague.

The devotion to the Infant Jesus of Prague began in the 16th century with a small statue of the Christ Child that came to symbolize the boundless love and care of God for all His children. According to tradition, the statue was a wedding gift to a Spanish noblewoman, who eventually gave it to the Carmelite monks in Prague. The monks placed it in their oratory, and the devotion grew rapidly as stories of answered prayers and miracles began to spread.

At the heart of this devotion is the profound truth of God becoming small and vulnerable in the Incarnation. The Christ Child reminds us that the Creator of the universe humbly entered the world as an infant, sharing in the joys and challenges of human life. Devotion to the Infant Jesus calls us to approach God with childlike trust, asking Him for our needs and resting in His providence. The statue's royal garments and crown also remind us of Christ's kingship, underscoring that even in His humility, He reigns as Lord over all.

In our parish, we have a beautiful side altar dedicated to the Infant Jesus of Prague, located on the township line side of the church. Many parishioners stop by this altar to light a candle and entrust their prayers to the Infant Jesus, asking for His guidance, healing, and peace. This altar serves as a reminder that, just as in Prague, we are invited to welcome Christ into our hearts with simple faith, trusting that He holds us close in all circumstances.

Please know that while I am here in Prague, I am keeping all of you in my prayers, especially before the shrine of the Infant Jesus. May His love and peace fill your hearts this week, and may we always approach Him with the trust and joy of children

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office, Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.

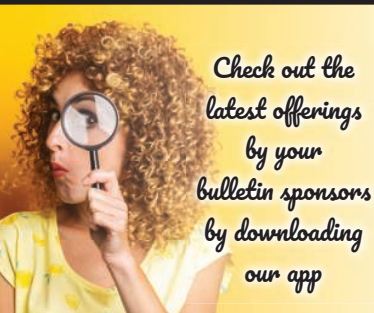
