From Father:

This Sunday, we gather to celebrate one of the most significant feasts in the Church's liturgical calendar—Pentecost. This day marks the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, transforming them into courageous witnesses of Christ's Resurrection and commissioning them to spread the Gospel to the ends of the earth. Pentecost is often referred to as the birthday of the Church because it signifies the beginning of the Church's mission in the world, empowered by the Holy Spirit.



We are also blessed to welcome Bishop McIntyre and the Archdiocese Catholic Charismatic Conference to our parish. The Charismatic Renewal within the Catholic Church emphasizes the active presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives through the use of gifts of the Holy Spirit, such as Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord. This movement calls us to a deeper, more personal relationship with Jesus Christ, one that is marked by fervent prayer, joyful worship, and an openness to the Holy Spirit's work within us.

As we reflect on the meaning of Pentecost, let us consider how the Holy Spirit is at work in our own lives. The same Spirit that descended upon the Apostles is given to each of us in Baptism and Confirmation, equipping us with gifts to serve the Church and the world. We are called to be witnesses of Christ's love, mercy, and truth in our daily lives.

In the words of St. Paul, "There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service, but the same Lord; there are different workings, but the same God who produces all of them in everyone" (1 Corinthians 12:4 -6). Each of us has been given unique gifts by the Holy Spirit, and together, we form the Body of Christ, working in harmony to build up the Church.

Let us pray for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit upon our parish, that we may be renewed in our commitment to living out the Gospel with boldness and love. As we celebrate this great feast, may the Holy Spirit fill us with His peace, joy, and courage to be faithful disciples of Christ. Let us continue to support one another in prayer and in our journey of faith, trusting that the Spirit will guide us in all things.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love. Amen.

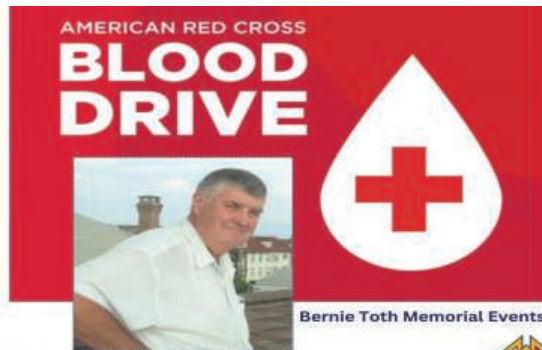

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
