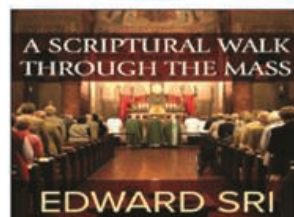
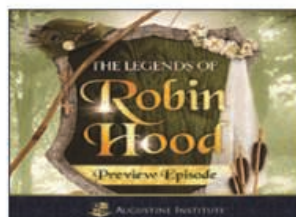

### From Father:

As the calendar turns to September, our attention is drawn to Labor Day, a day dedicated to celebrating the contributions of workers and the fruits of their labor. From a Catholic perspective, Labor Day is not merely a holiday for barbecues and relaxation, but an occasion to reflect on the inherent dignity of work and its role in human flourishing.

Central to Catholic social teaching is the principle that work is not just a means to an end, but a fundamental expression of human dignity. The very act of work reflects the divine image within us, as we are called to be co-creators with God in shaping the world around us. Pope St. John Paul II eloquently emphasized this in his encyclical *Laborem Exercens*, stating that "work is a good thing for man—a good thing for his humanity—because through work man not only transforms nature, adapting it to his own needs, but he also achieves fulfillment as a human being and indeed, in a sense, becomes 'more a human being.'"

Labor Day offers an opportunity to consider the balance between work, rest, and family life. In a society that often places excessive emphasis on material success and productivity, the Catholic perspective reminds us of the importance of a healthy work-life balance. Allowing time for rest, reflection, and spending quality moments with loved ones not only rejuvenates the individual but also nurtures the bonds that hold families and communities together.

Let us strive for a society that values and upholds the rights and dignity of every worker, creating a world where our labor becomes a tangible expression of our shared journey towards flourishing and fulfillment.

First Saturday of the month after 8:30 a.m. Mass or by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.
