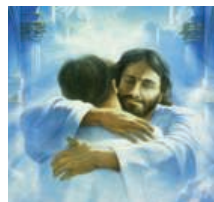

## From Father:

This coming Wednesday, we begin the season of Lent with the celebration of Ash Wednesday. This year, Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day, giving all husbands an excuse to postpone dinners till later in the week. Lent is the penitential season of approximately 40 days set aside by the Church in order for the faithful to prepare for the celebration of the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. During this holy season, inextricably connected to the Paschal Mystery, the Catechumens prepare for Christian initiation, and current Church members prepare for Easter by a recalling of Baptism and by works of penance, that is, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Our Parish is having a number of activities and devotions to assist us in making Lent fruitful for our spiritual lives. We will be having Stations of the Cross every **Friday at 6:30 PM**. Friday is a traditional day of penance, and Stations is a great way of keeping Christ crucified at the center of our lives this season. Also, the Parish Life Committee is hosting a Soup and Song on **March 1st** at 7 pm.

As a reminder, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting (only one full meal with two snacks) and abstinence (no meat) for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence (no meat). The law of abstinence forbids the eating of meat (of mammals and birds). However, eggs, milk products, fish, shellfish, and all other cold-blooded animals may be eaten, e.g., snails. Similarly, small quantities of condiments (i.e., flavorings) made from animal fat, other meat-derived products, and meat broth may be eaten (note, however, that a meat soup with large chunks of meat would seem to move from the category of broth to that of forbidden meat).

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

- If Colonial is closed, the parish office and chapel are closed. Scheduled meetings will be canceled unless otherwise notified.
- If you have questions or need help rescheduling appointments or meetings you can call the parish office when we return. Or if it's an emergency, please call Father O'Donald.

### Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

### Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

### Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
