## From Father:

In this week's reading from Ephesians, St. Paul offers us a profound challenge: "Be subordinate to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Ephesians 5:21). At first glance, this call to submission may seem counter-cultural, especially in a world that often values independence and self-assertion. However, Paul's exhortation is rooted in the very heart of the Christian life and offers us a deeper understanding of what it means to live in community as followers of Christ.

To be "subordinate" to one another is not about diminishing our dignity or worth. Rather, it is a call to humility and service. This mutual submission is an invitation to recognize Christ in each other and to treat one another with the same love and respect that Christ has for us. It is a call to put the needs and well-being of others before our own, fostering a community where love, peace, and understanding prevail.

This call is particularly relevant within our families, friendships, and parish community. In our daily interactions, how often do we seek to understand the perspectives of others, to listen with compassion, and to respond with patience? How often do we prioritize the needs of those around us, even when it requires sacrifice on our part?


St. Paul's teaching reminds us that our relationships are not simply about what we can gain, but about how we can serve one another. In doing so, we reflect the love of Christ, who "came not to be served, but to serve" (Mark 10:45). This spirit of service is the foundation of a healthy and vibrant Christian community.

Moreover, Paul links this call to mutual submission directly to our reverence for Christ. When we serve others with humility and love, we do so out of respect and honor for the Lord who first loved us. Our actions become a living testament to the faith we profess, a witness to the transformative power of God's grace in our lives.

As we meditate on this passage, let us ask ourselves how we can better live out this call in our daily lives. How can we embody the spirit of mutual submission in our families, in our parish, and in our wider community? By embracing this call, we not only strengthen our relationships but also grow closer to Christ, who is the source of all love and unity.

May we, as a parish, strive to live in harmony and love, subordinating ourselves to one another out of reverence for Christ. Let us encourage and support each other in this journey, knowing that in serving one another, we serve the Lord Himself.

To register in the parish, arrange for a baptism, or request a Certificate of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, contact the Parish Office during office hours at eol@epiphanyofourlord.com. Also, please advise our office staff of any change of address, telephone number or family status.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

#### Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month. Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office, Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

#### Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.

#### Holy Communion for the Sick and Homebound
