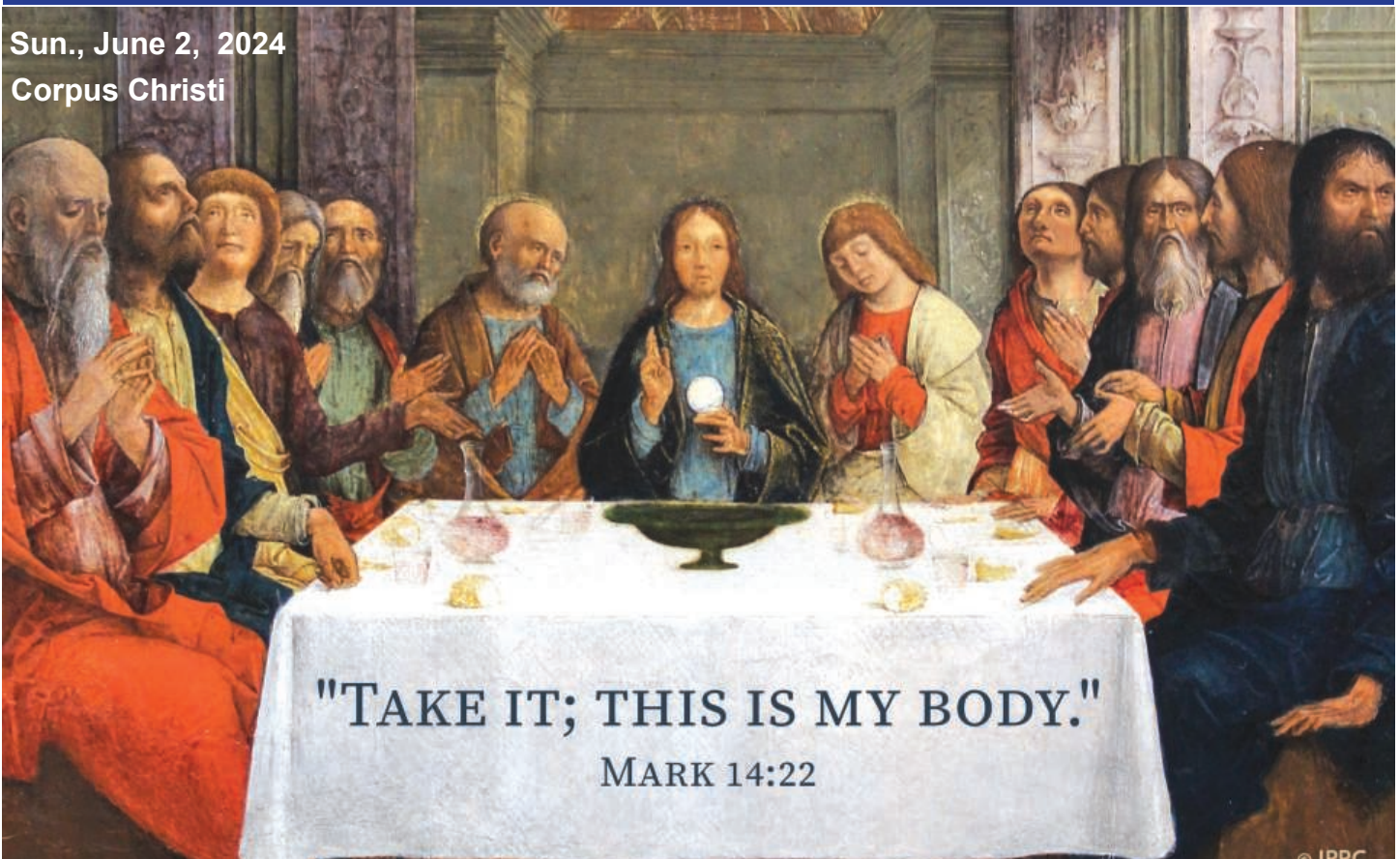

From Father:

As we step into the month of June, our hearts and minds turn towards a profound and beautiful devotion within our Catholic faith: the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This month is specially dedicated to honoring and deepening our devotion to the Sacred Heart, a symbol of Christ's infinite love and compassion for humanity.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has its roots in the revelations given to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary and showed her His heart, burning with love for all people. He expressed His desire for the faithful to draw closer to His Heart, to find in it an endless source of mercy, grace, and tenderness.

The image of the Sacred Heart, often depicted with flames of love, a crown of thorns, and a cross, reminds us of Christ's sacrificial love. The flames signify the burning love Jesus has for each one of us, the crown of thorns represents the pain and suffering He endured for our salvation, and the cross is a symbol of His ultimate sacrifice. Together, these elements call us to reflect on His unwavering love and the immense mercy that flows from His heart.

Why should we cultivate a devotion to the Sacred Heart? Here are a few reasons:

A Deeper Relationship with Jesus: Devotion to the Sacred Heart invites us into a closer, more intimate relationship with Jesus. It encourages us to see His heart as the source of all consolation and strength, especially in times of trial and suffering.

A Source of Mercy and Forgiveness: The Sacred Heart is a powerful reminder of Christ's infinite mercy. When we turn to His heart in repentance, we are assured of His boundless forgiveness and grace.

A Call to Love and Compassion: Embracing the Sacred Heart devotion transforms our own hearts, making us more loving, compassionate, and merciful. It challenges us to love others as Christ loves us, with a selfless and sacrificial love.

A Path to Holiness: Through devotion to the Sacred Heart, we are drawn into a deeper commitment to holiness. It inspires us to live out our faith more fully, striving to embody the love and virtues of Christ in our daily lives.

To cultivate this devotion, consider incorporating the following practices into your spiritual life this month:

Pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart: This beautiful litany is a powerful prayer that helps us meditate on the various aspects of Christ's love.

First Fridays Devotion: Attend Mass and receive Holy Communion on the first Friday of each month, offering reparation for the sins committed against the Sacred Heart.

Enthronement of the Sacred Heart in Your Home: This practice involves placing an image of the Sacred Heart in a prominent place in your home and dedicating your family to His care and protection.

As we honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus this June, let us open our hearts to His transformative love. May this devotion draw us closer to Him and inspire us to be vessels of His love and mercy in the world.

Retreat for Catholics Affected by Divorce and Separation

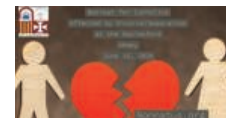

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
