### From Father:

We find ourselves in the midst of two deeply meaningful feast days—All Saints Day on Friday, November 1st, and All Souls Day on Saturday, November 2nd. These solemn celebrations remind us of the profound unity we share as members of the Body of Christ, spanning across time and eternity.

On All Saints Day, we honor the Church Triumphant, those holy men and women who have gone before us and now rejoice in the full presence of God. They are our role models, our friends in heaven, constantly interceding for us. Their lives of heroic virtue inspire us in our own journey of faith, and their presence calls us to join in the hope of one day sharing that same glory. We are reminded that the saints are not distant figures but rather part of our family in the Mystical Body of Christ. Their prayers strengthen us, their witness encourages us, and their example calls us to live more fully for God and others.

Then, on All Souls Day, we remember the Church Penitent—the souls of the faithful departed who are undergoing purification. These are our loved ones, our friends, and all those who still await the fullness of God's embrace. Our prayers for them, particularly during Mass, are a beautiful way to remain connected in love and hope, hastening their journey to the fullness of heaven. In this sacred act, we fulfill our role as the Church Militant, those of us still on the journey, striving to support our brothers and sisters through prayer and sacrifice. Just as we count on the saints in heaven to intercede for us, so too are we called to intercede for those souls in need of our prayers. This bond of love and prayer we share is a tangible sign of the communion we have in the Mystical Body of Christ—a communion that transcends even death itself.

As members of the Mystical Body, we are united beyond the limits of time and space. The saints, the souls in purgatory, and we who are still on earth are all bound together in Christ's love. This connection is what makes the Church a living and dynamic family, one in which each member plays a role. The Church Triumphant cheers us on, the Church Penitent receives our help, and we, the Church Militant, strive to live lives of holiness, ever mindful of our destiny in Christ. The Mystical Body of Christ is a beautiful reality that gives us hope, knowing that we are never isolated in our journey of faith. We belong to something far greater than ourselves—a divine family held together by God's infinite love and mercy.

May these feast days remind us that we are never alone. Whether in triumph, in purification, or in struggle, we are bound together as one Church, united in Christ's love that spans beyond the grave..



To register in the parish, arrange for a baptism, or request a Certificate of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, contact the Parish Office during office hours at [eol@epiphanyofourlord.com](mailto:eol@epiphanyofourlord.com).

Also, please advise our office staff of any change of address, telephone number or family status.

**Anointing of the Sick**

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

**Baptism**

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

**Matrimony**

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
