## From Father:

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph—a feast that invites us to reflect on the beauty, sanctity, and mission of family life. As the domestic church, the family is not only a place of love and care but also the first school of faith, virtue, and discipleship.

The Holy Family, though unique in its divine purpose, also experienced the joys and challenges common to all families. They faced uncertainty as they fled to Egypt, lived humbly in Nazareth, and navigated the normal rhythms of daily life. Through it all, they remained united in faith, trust, and mutual love. Their example offers us guidance for our own family lives, especially in a world that often devalues the sacredness of this institution.

### Jesus: The Heart of the Family

In every Christian home, Christ must be at the center, just as He was in the home of Mary and Joseph. Through prayer, the reading of Scripture, and the sacraments, families are invited to deepen their relationship with the Lord and with one another. The Eucharist, especially, strengthens the bond of love that unites family members, allowing the grace of Christ to flow into daily interactions.

### Mary: The Model of Love and Obedience

Mary's fiat—her "yes" to God's plan—is a profound example for every mother, father, and child. Her unwavering trust in God reminds us of the importance of surrendering our plans to His will, especially in moments of difficulty or uncertainty. In her care for Jesus and Joseph, Mary embodies the selfless love that is at the heart of family life.

### Joseph: The Protector and Provider

Joseph, the silent saint, teaches us the value of humility, hard work, and faithfulness. He protected his family, provided for their needs, and fulfilled his role as the spiritual leader of his household. Fathers and mothers alike can look to Joseph as an example of loving service and dedication.

### The Call to Holiness in Family Life

While no family is perfect, every family is called to grow in holiness. This feast reminds us that holiness is not reserved for extraordinary moments but is found in the small, everyday acts of love, patience, and forgiveness. By embracing these virtues, families become a reflection of God's love in the world.

As we prepare to enter the new year, let us ask the Holy Family to intercede for us, so that our homes may be places of peace, joy, and faith. May we strive to follow their example, bringing Christ into the center of our lives and sharing His love with one another.

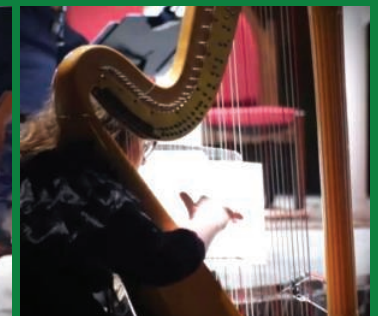

## Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

## Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

## Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
