Listen to the voice of creation

The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation on **Thursday, Sept. 1**, marks the beginning of the Season of Creation, which lasts until Oct. 4, the feast of St. Francis of Assisi.

Pope Francis, in his message for this year's World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, wrote, "For the followers of Christ in particular, this...reinforces our awareness that 'all things came into being through him, and without him not one thing came into being' (Jn. 1:3). In this Season of Creation, we pray once more in the great cathedral of creation, and revel in the 'grandiose cosmic choir' (St. John Paul II, General Audience, 10 July 2002) made up of countless creatures, all singing the praises of God. Let us join St. Francis of Assisi in singing: 'Praise be to you, my Lord, for all your creatures' (cf. Canticle of Brother Sun). Let us join the psalmist in singing, 'Let everything that breathes praise the Lord!'" (Ps. 150:6).

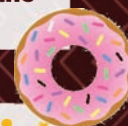

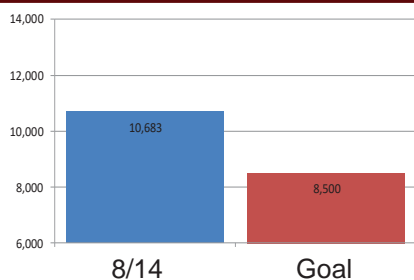

First Saturday of the month after 8:30 a.m. Mass or by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.
