**From Father:**

Greetings from Mary House!

We are currently in Ephesus, where Mary lived with St. John before she was assumed into heaven. It is also the spot of the Council of Ephesus in 431 AD, which declared Mary, the Theotokos the mother of God. In the past few days, we visited Philippi, where Saint Paul established the first church in Europe and to whom he wrote the Letter to the Philippians.

We have had wonderful weather during our trip and have seen some amazing sights, especially at the Meteora Monasteries. In the eleventh century, monks settled within the caves. As the Ottoman occupation increased, the monks were forced to move their settlements higher up on the rocks until they were unreachable by any opposing enemy. Using ropes and ladders, the monks brought baskets of building materials and living supplies, transforming the settlements into monasteries.

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.
