It also invites us to reflect on the importance of all vocations of self-sacrifice, including the military, firefighters, emergency care workers, and others who dedicate their lives to the safety and well-being of others.*

*These vocations remind us of Jesus' words in John 15:13: "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." 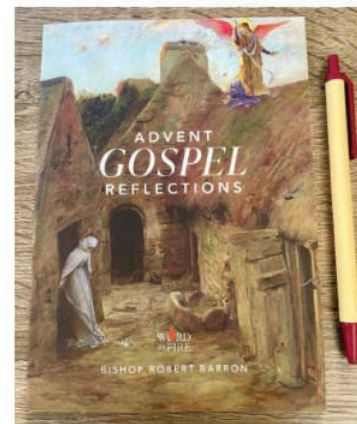
### Advent 2024 Book

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

**Baptism**

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office, Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.
