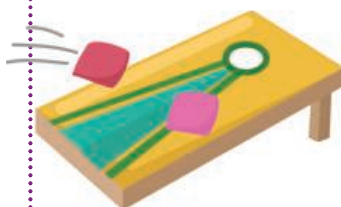

In **2023** our **11** active and **8** associate members were responsible for:

**26** home visits  
to **118** neighbors  
who were facing eviction,  
who needed their utility bills paid,  
who needed food,

This direct aid totaled over **\$7,720**

We assisted an additional **1,214** people

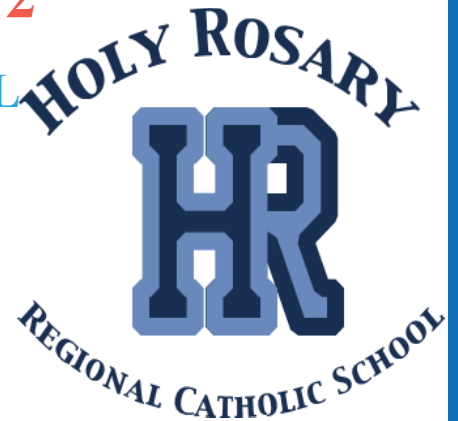

## From Father:

On this 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time, our liturgical readings guide us through profound lessons of faith, obedience, and the transformative power of God's word.

In our first reading from the Book of Jonah (3:1-5, 10), we encounter the familiar story of Jonah's call to preach repentance to the people of Nineveh. Despite his initial reluctance, Jonah's eventual obedience leads to a remarkable transformation among the people of Nineveh. This passage challenges us to consider our own responses to God's calls in our lives. Are we like Jonah, initially hesitant or resistant? Yet, the story of Jonah is a testament to God's patience and mercy, reminding us that it's never too late to embrace God's plan for us.

The second reading from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians calls us to live in readiness for God's judgment. St. Paul's words remind us that our time on earth is fleeting and that we should live in a manner that reflects our readiness to meet the Lord. This message urges us to examine our daily lives: Are we living in a way that shows we are prepared to meet God, embracing the Gospel in our actions and decisions?

The Gospel from Mark 1:14-20 narrates the beginning of Jesus' public ministry, proclaiming the Good News and calling His first disciples. Jesus' message was revolutionary, offering a path to divine sonship and eternal life. His teachings, life, death, and resurrection form the cornerstone of our faith - a message that, as the Gospel reminds us, is as relevant today as it was two thousand years ago.

As we reflect on these readings, let us ask ourselves: How are we responding to Christ's call today? Are we, like the first disciples, ready to leave our nets and follow Him? This call is not just a historical event; it's a living invitation to each of us to participate in God's redemptive plan for humanity.

Our journey of faith is a response to this invitation. Like Jonah, we may have our moments of reluctance or doubt, but God's patience and mercy are inexhaustible. Like the Corinthians, we are reminded to live with an awareness of God's presence and judgment. And like the first disciples, we are called to follow Christ, making His mission our own.

This Sunday, let us embrace these readings as a call to deeper faith and commitment. Let us seek to live in a way that reflects our readiness to respond to God's call, whether it leads us to unexpected places, like Jonah, or asks us to leave our comfort zones, like the first disciples.
