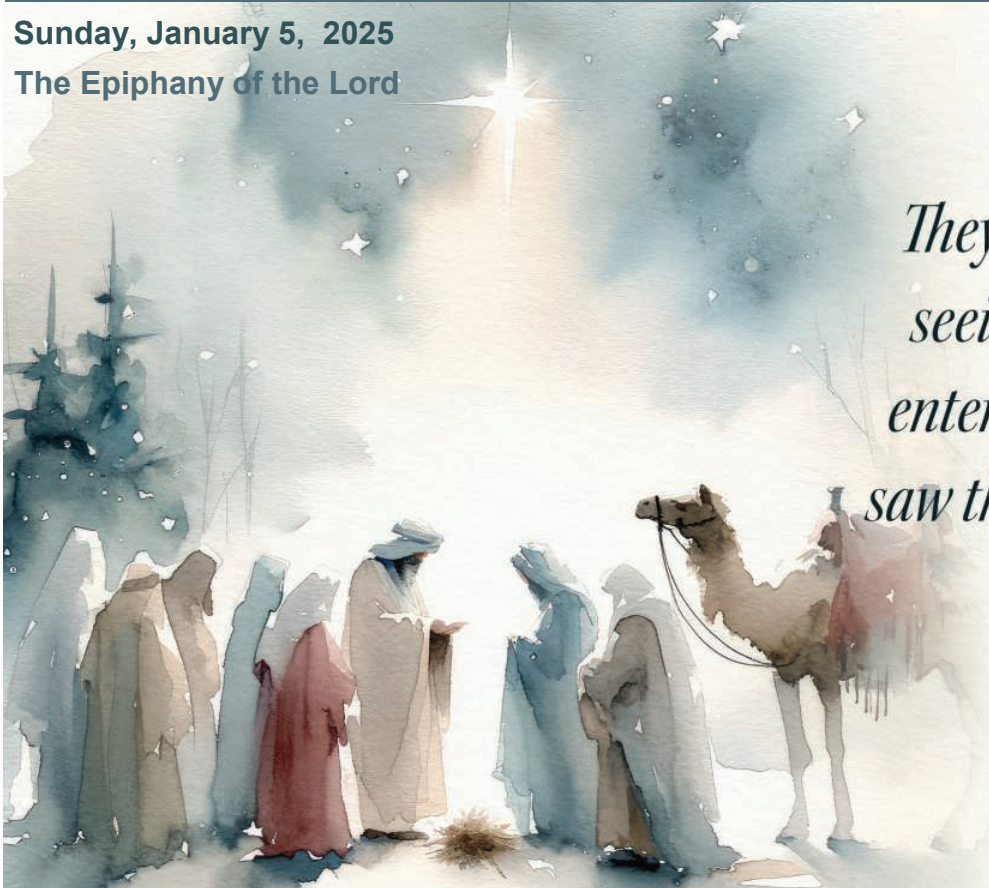

## From Father:

This weekend, we gather to celebrate the great Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, our parish's patronal feast day. The word Epiphany means "manifestation" or "revelation," and it is a feast rich with meaning for our lives as Catholics and as members of this parish family.

The story of the Magi from the Gospel of Matthew reminds us that Jesus Christ came not just for a select few but for all nations and all peoples. The wise men, guided by the light of a star, represent the longing of every human heart to seek and find truth, goodness, and beauty. Their journey to Bethlehem reminds us of our own journey of faith—a pilgrimage toward Christ, who is the Light of the World.



In the gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, we see a profound recognition of Jesus' identity: gold for His kingship, frankincense for His divinity, and myrrh for His sacrifice.



These gifts remind us that we, too, are called to offer the best of who we are to the Lord, surrendering our hearts in worship and service.

As the parish of Epiphany of Our Lord, this feast challenges us to reflect on our mission as a community of faith. Just as the star led the Magi to Christ, we are called to be lights in the world, guiding others to encounter the living Lord. In our worship, our outreach, and our daily lives, we are to make Jesus known and loved in our homes, workplaces, and neighborhoods.

The Epiphany is also a feast of joy and hope. It proclaims that no matter how distant or far off someone might seem, God's love seeks them out. In this new year, let us renew our commitment to being a parish where that love is made visible—a community where everyone is welcome to encounter the grace and truth of Jesus Christ.

On this special day for our parish, I invite you to take a moment to reflect on the blessings of being part of Epiphany of Our Lord Church. May we, like the Magi, always seek the Lord with open hearts, offer Him the treasures of our lives, and share the light of His love with the world.

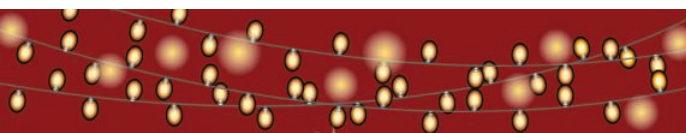

## Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

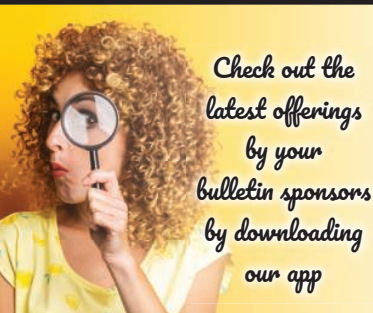
