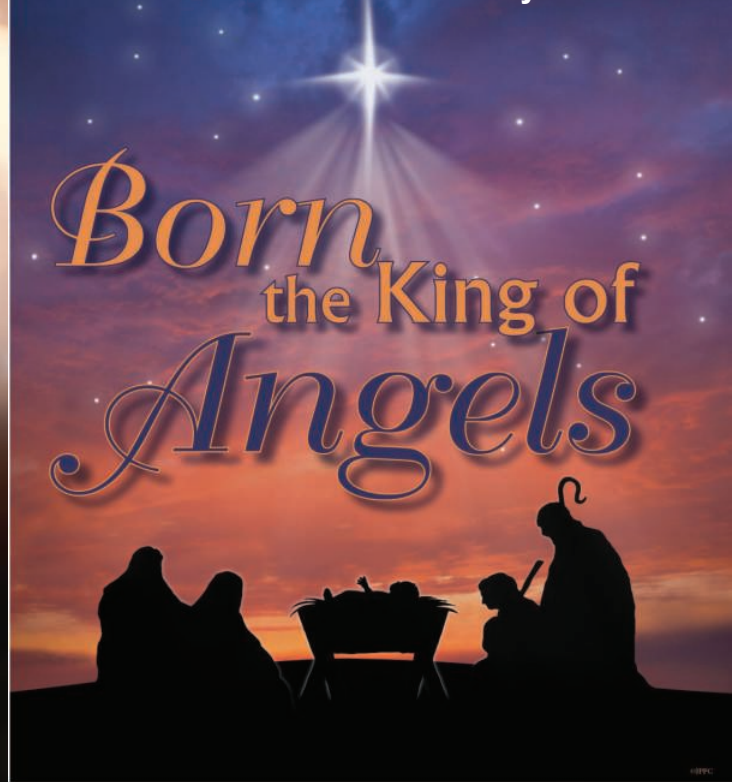

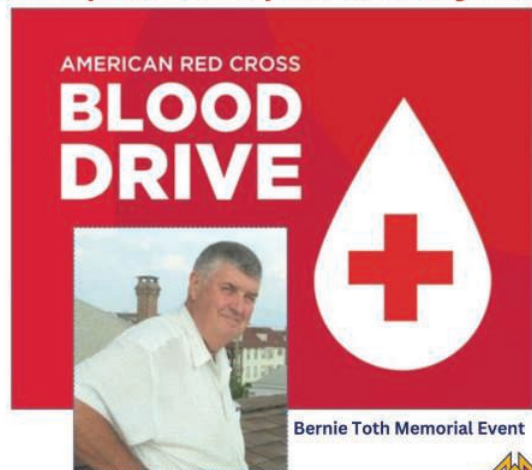

## From Father:

*This Christmas, we are invited to join the shepherds on their journey—a path that begins in the extraordinary radiance of heaven and leads to the simplicity of a manger. When the angels proclaimed the birth of Christ, their heavenly song filled the shepherds with awe and fear. Yet, it also left them with a deep, human joy—a glow of expectation and hope that directed them to Bethlehem.*

*The shepherds' experience reminds us that God's glory often leads us not to grandeur but to humility. They left behind the angelic vision and heavenly light to encounter a child—not a child of wealth or splendor, but one wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. This was the promised sign: a profound message that God meets us in the ordinariness of our lives.*

*Like the shepherds, we too are called to journey from the extraordinary to the ordinary, from light to darkness, and from divine mystery to human encounter. Christ's birth teaches us that God's love is not found in displays of power but in solidarity with the poor, the bound, and the lowly. In becoming man, Jesus embraced our humanity, descending into the depths of our struggles, sorrows, and even our insignificance. He shows us that true glory is found in serving others, in acts of love, and in walking alongside those in need.*

*As we celebrate this holy season, let us remember that Christmas is not merely an event but a mission. The joy of the angels' song and the peace proclaimed on earth call us to carry Christ's light into the world. We are sent to bring hope to the hopeless, to serve the poor, and to lift up those in bondage—not through our strength but through the grace of God working within us.*

*This Christmas, may we find in the manger's simplicity the miracle of God's presence among us. May the humility of the Christ Child inspire us to embrace our own call to love and serve. And may the words of the angel echo in our hearts: "Be not afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy." Indeed, today, a Savior is born—and He continues to dwell with us, guiding us on the path of divine love.*

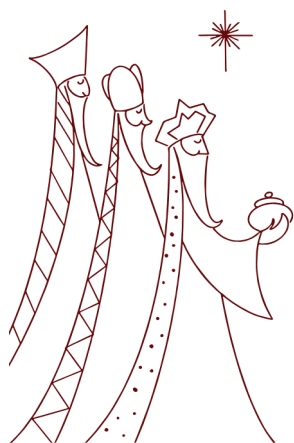

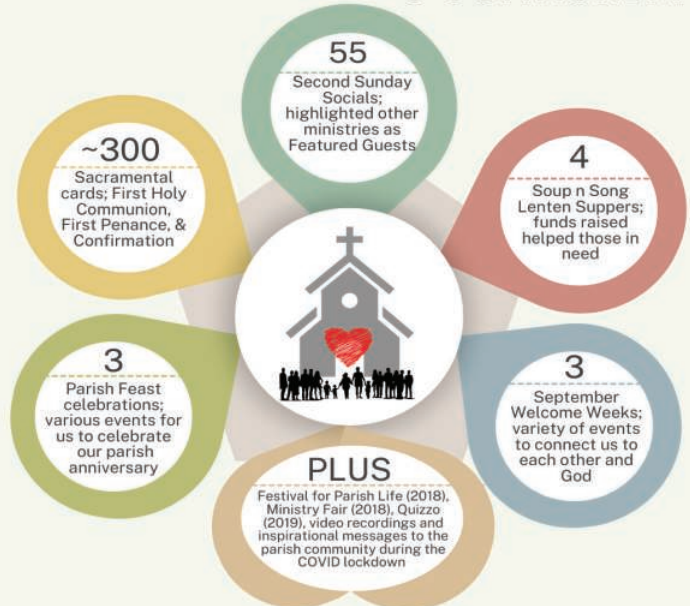

## Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

## Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

## Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
