\*\*If you wish to donate a turkey purchased at another store, please first call us to arrange a drop off due to very limited freezer space.
2. Purchase the rest of the food items (from any store of your preference).
3. **Drop off the food** to volunteers at the front door of Parish center/school or leave in church vestibule **at the Saturday, Nov 19 vigil mass & Sunday, Nov 20 masses.**

**Important Note for 2022:** the stores are unable to offer the popular 'Pressed for Time' option (where we collect your cash or check & they do the shopping) due to very limited supplies. In fact, they strongly suggest that you purchase any non-perishable items as soon as possible so that you have them for the drop-off collection later in November!! We are greatly concerned that the lack of this popular option will affect donation volume. And so, in a year when the food need is so great, we are pleading that all go the extra mile to shop for the food needed by our hungry neighbors.

**From Father:**

The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life, but have not yet attained the joys of heaven. St. Paul warns us that we must not be ignorant concerning the dead, nor sorrowful, "even as others who have no hope...For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven...and the dead who are in Christ shall rise.

The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Even in the Old Testament prayers and alms were offered for the souls of the dead by those who thought "well and religiously concerning the resurrection." It was believed that "they who had fallen asleep with godliness had great grace laid up for them" and that "it is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins." We know that a defiled soul cannot enter into heaven.

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.
