

- Rouen: where we'll visit the historic Cathedral and the site of Saint Joan of Arc's martyrdom.*

- Mont-Saint-Michel: a UNESCO World Heritage site with breathtaking views and the renowned abbey, where we will join the monks in prayer.*

- Normandy: a day dedicated to remembering the courage of those who fought in the D-Day landings, with visits to Omaha Beach and the American Cemetery.*

- Chartres: home to one of the most beautiful Gothic cathedrals in the world, a site of deep Marian devotion.*

*This pilgrimage offers daily Mass, prayerful moments, and opportunities to explore the rich Catholic heritage of France. Whether you are seeking to deepen your faith, honor Saint Thérèse, or experience France's spiritual landmarks, we invite you to embark on this profound journey with us.*

## The World Day of the Poor

This year the World Day of the Poor is this **Sunday, Nov. 17**. The theme for this year's celebration is *"The prayer of the poor rises up to God"*.

Before the Mass in Rome, Pope Francis will bless 13 keys, each representing a country where the Vicentians will start a new "13 Houses" project. The project will build new homes for people in need and offer charitable initiatives.

Pope Francis established the World Day of the Poor in 2017. His message for the 2024 celebration encourages people to pray for and with the poor, and to be aware of their needs. He also asks people to consider what they can do to make 2025 a year of hope, given the challenges of war, the pandemic, and the climate crisis.

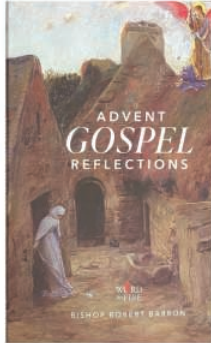
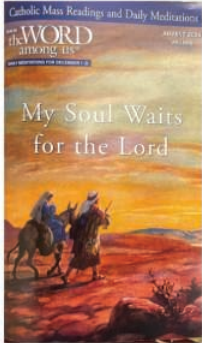
## Low Gluten Hosts

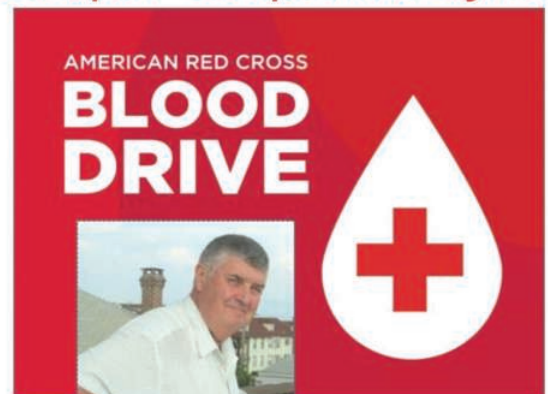

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

**Matrimony**

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
