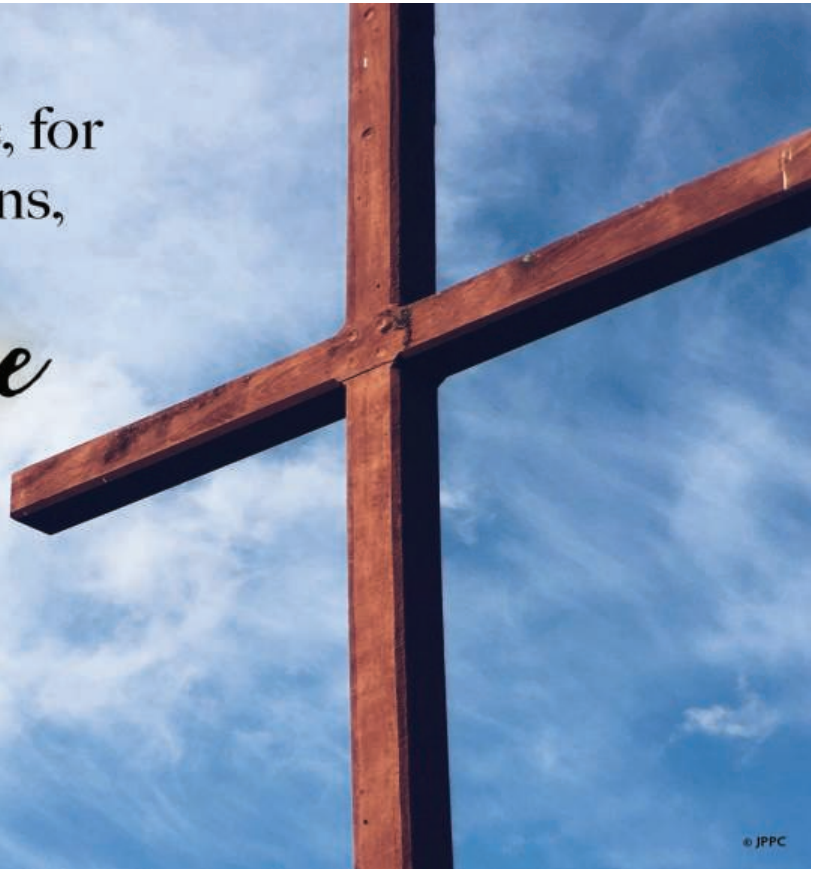



WORLD DAY of PRAYER for VOCATIONS

Sunday, Apr. 21

From Father:

This year, the Feast of the Annunciation, normally celebrated nine months before Christmas on March 25th, was transferred to this last week. We gathered to celebrate the Feast of the Annunciation, we are called to reflect deeply on the profound mysteries of Mary's fiat—her joyous "yes" to God—and the wondrous reality of the Incarnation. This solemnity does not just commemorate an event of the distant past; it illuminates the path of our own discipleship and the incredible humility of God's love for us.

In the Annunciation, the Angel Gabriel brought to Mary a message that would forever alter the course of history. She was to be the Mother of God. Mary's response, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38), was not a passive acceptance but an active, courageous assent to God's will. Her fiat was the ultimate act of trust and obedience in God, embodying the perfect model of faith for all Christians.

Mary's yes teaches us the power and beauty of divine submission. In our daily lives, we are continually called to echo Mary's fiat in our actions, decisions, and prayers, trusting in God's plan for us and opening ourselves to the workings of the Holy Spirit.

The Feast of the Annunciation celebrates the moment God's infinite majesty took on human nature, a mystery that remains at the heart of Christian faith. In the womb of Mary, by the power of the Holy Spirit, God became man. The Word, through whom all things were made, chose to become a helpless zygote, growing as any human child does, in the silent, nurturing space of a mother's womb. This mystery of the Incarnation reveals God's boundless humility and His desire to be intimately united with humanity.

The Incarnation is a testament to the sanctity of life from its earliest stages and a reminder of the immeasurable value of every human being, created in the image and likeness of God. As we meditate on this mystery, let us remember our call to respect and cherish life at all stages, recognizing the face of Christ in each other.

The Feast of the Annunciation invites us to live the mystery of the Incarnation in our lives. By following Mary's example of faith and obedience, we open ourselves to God's transformative love and grace. Let us say our own fiat to God, embracing His will for us with joy and trust.

May our celebration of this feast deepen our understanding of the love and humility of God, who became man so that we might know Him, love Him, and be called into communion with Him. May Mary, the Mother of God and our mother, guide us to her Son and help us to live our lives as a reflection of her obedient, trusting yes.

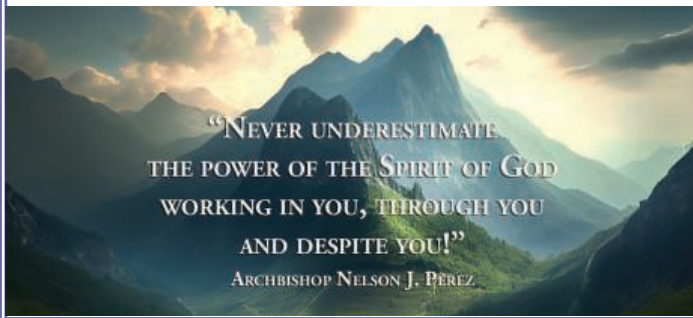

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.
