A CYO basketball alum and currently a senior at Plymouth Whitemarsh HS is battling Stage 3 Hodgkin's Lymphoma Cancer.

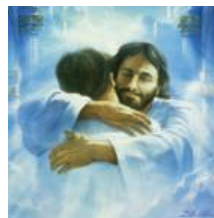

## From Father:

As we gather on this Fourth Sunday of Lent, also known as Laetare Sunday, we are invited to rejoice amidst our Lenten journey. The Church, in her wisdom, offers us a moment of respite and encouragement, symbolized by the rose-colored vestments that may adorn our sanctuaries. This Sunday serves as a beacon of hope, reminding us that Easter's glory is drawing near, even as we continue our path of conversion and preparation.

Our Gospel today, from John 3:14-21, is a profound reflection on the nature of God's love and the purpose of Christ's mission on earth. In speaking to Nicodemus, Jesus draws a parallel between the bronze serpent lifted by Moses in the desert and His own lifting up on the cross. This imagery is rich in salvation history, revealing God's unchanging desire to save, not condemn, to heal, not harm.

"Jesus said to Nicodemus: 'Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.'"

At the heart of this passage lies the most well-known verse of the Christian faith, John 3:16, a verse that encapsulates the Gospel message: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." Here, we are reminded of the depth of God's love—a love so profound that He gave His only Son for our salvation.

As we reflect on this message, we see a clear distinction between light and darkness, symbolizing faith and disbelief, good and evil. Christ is the light that has come into the world, yet, as the Gospel tells us, "people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil." This preference for darkness is not merely a rejection of Christ's teachings but a rejection of the truth and love that He embodies.

Yet, the Gospel also offers us a message of hope and invitation. It reassures us that "whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God." This Lenten season, we are called to examine how we respond to Christ's light. Do we shy away from it, fearing exposure of our sins, or do we embrace it, allowing God's grace to transform our lives?

Laetare Sunday is an opportunity to renew our commitment to living in the truth, to embracing the light of Christ fully. It is a time to assess our spiritual journey, recognizing areas of darkness in our lives and inviting the light of Christ to illuminate and guide us. In doing so, we prepare ourselves not only for the celebration of Easter but for the eternal life promised to us through faith in Jesus Christ.

Let us, therefore, rejoice on this Laetare Sunday, comforted and encouraged by God's immense love and the promise of salvation. May our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving draw us ever closer to the light of Christ, transforming our lives and preparing our hearts for the joy of the Resurrection.
