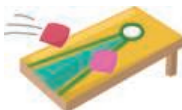

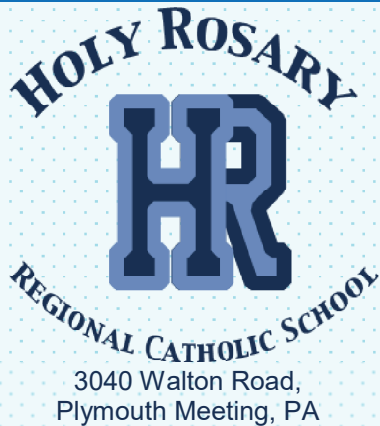

New Inclement Weather Policy: Keeping Our Parish Safe

This winter, we are making up for the lack of snow these past few years. As the winter season continues, bringing with it the beauty and challenges of snow, our parish community's safety remains a paramount concern. To ensure the well-being of all our members and to provide clear guidance in times of inclement weather, we are introducing a new policy regarding parish operations during snowfall.

Our new inclement weather policy is designed with the utmost consideration for the safety and convenience of our parishioners. The policy outlines specific criteria for when the parish will close, taking into account weather forecasts, road conditions, and local advisories. It also helps us at the parish be able to properly plow and get the campus in a safe condition. This policy is for weekdays only, as the obligation to attend mass on Sundays remains an Archdiocesan decision (Although one is never obligated to attend mass if travel conditions would put you or your family in danger). The policy is outlined in the bulletin, on the next page, so please take time to read it over.

Our Policy is to keep you safe when the weather causes hazardous conditions for travel. Your safety is our concern.

Our clergy, staff and members will work with you to reschedule important meetings.

CLOSING INFORMATION

- Our parish follows the lead of the Colonial School District with regard to weekday Mass and the delayed opening/closing of the parish office due to inclement weather.
- When Colonial has a two-hour delay, or closes, our 8:30 a.m. weekday Mass will be cancelled, and the Mass intention will be celebrated privately by the priest.
- In the event of a Colonial School District two-hour delay, the parish office and chapel will open two hours late.
- If Colonial is closed, the parish office and chapel are closed. Scheduled meetings will be canceled unless otherwise notified.
- If you have questions or need help rescheduling appointments or meetings you can call the parish office when we return. Or if it's an emergency, please call Father O'Donald.

Parish Office Requests

To register in the parish, arrange for a baptism, or request a Certificate of Eligibility for sponsorship at Baptism or Confirmation, contact the Parish Office during office hours at eol@epiphanyofourlord.com.

Also, please advise our office staff of any change of address, telephone number or family status.

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the sick is by request. Please notify the Parish Office as soon as possible when any parishioner becomes seriously ill or is admitted to the hospital.

Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10 a.m. Mass on Sundays upon request. Both first-time parents need to attend a Pre-Jordan class, which is held the first Wednesday of every month.

Pre-Registration for the class is required by contacting the Parish Office. Sponsors not from Epiphany are required to submit a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish two weeks prior to the Baptism.

Matrimony

Notify the Parish Office of your intention to marry at least six months before the date of the wedding to assure sufficient preparation and to arrange for Pre-Cana sessions.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the sick and homebound. Call the Parish Office at (610) 828-8634 to provide the office staff with the name, address and phone number of the sick or homebound parishioner.
